1. RFQ - INTERNAL AUDIT OF DENEL INTERGRATED SOLUTION SYSTEMS INTERGRATED BUSINESS MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS (IBMS)

Denel SOC Ltd is a state-owned listed as a Schedule 2 public entity that operates and accounts for its activities in accordance with the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) Act No 1 of 1999 as amended. Denel SOC Ltd is commercially-driven company and strategic partner for innovative defence, security and related technology solutions. It groups together several defence and aerospace divisions and associated companies.

Denel provides turn-key solutions of defence equipment to its clients by designing, developing, integrating and supporting artillery, munitions, missiles, aero structures, aircraft maintenance, unmanned aerial vehicle systems and optical payloads based on high-end technology. Its defence capabilities date back more than 70 years when some of Denel's first manufacturing plants were established.

2. REQUIREMENTS BACKGROUND

The purpose of this scope of work is to outline the requirements for conducting an independent internal audit of the ISS Integrated Business Management System (IBMS). As a sovereign technology partner and system integrator to the Defence, National, and Civil Security sectors, ISS supports the realization and life-cycle management of complex systems.

This internal audit will assess ISS' compliance with ISO 9001:2015 standards and verify the effectiveness of the IBMS in achieving its intended outcomes, aligning with quality standards, and meeting readiness requirements for ISO 9001:2015 certification.

The audit's goal is to verify whether ISS is prepared for ISO 9001:2015 certification. The internal audit will include a thorough review of the Document Data Index (DDI) and assess whether the policies, processes, and procedures in the ISS IBMS manual are documented, controlled, communicated, and maintained according to standard requirements. This audit will follow ISO 9001:2015's verification methodology, applying the Standard's requirements to ISS-specific processes and systems.
