Schools Outreach Programme

- Denel's CSI flagship intervention the Schools Outreach Programme (SOP) – provides extra tuition in Mathematics, Physical Science, English and Life Sciences to high school learners
- The Programme contributes an **extra 65 learning days** to the Department of Basic Education's (DBE) school calendar
- In 2016 we supported 450 learners in Grades 10 12.
- The programme is in 6 Provinces (Gauteng, Mpumalanga, Limpopo, Eastern Cape, KwaZulu-Natal & the North West)

- Meet Silinda Manelisi, one of our Denel SOP learners, currently in Grade 12 at Steenbok High School, Mpumalanga.
- In Grade 11 Silinda achieved 98% and 91% for Maths and Science respectively.
- He is the overall Top Learner for the year 2016.



Denel offers bursaries for Engineering and related qualifications.

- In 2016, we had 81 bursars spread across South African Universities
- Denel spent over R16mil towards these bursaries
